






ANNUAL REVENUES*

(in million pesos)






Most or 77% of the as of the 2021 Annual Revenue is generated from the Licensing Fees of CEZA. This is followed by the, Processing Fees, Seaport System Fees, Rental/Lease Income, while the other sources of income only contribute 1-1.55% of the total revenue.





Number of Locators








In 2021, four locators/investors were added to the total number of locators of CEZA, which is now 139. The number of locators has an increase of 3% from its previous number.



TOURIST ARRIVALS





Despite the continuous plight on the pandemic, CEZA was still able to increase its tourist arrivals. In 2021, it doubled the number of its visitors, 101.79% increase or an additional of 50,306 from the previous data.






TOURIST ARRIVALS

Total Tourist- 99,729






NUMBER OF FLIGHTS ACCOMODATED

* There were no international flights during the year 2021 so far.






Number of Passengers



(Number of Ship Calls)









Ratio of All Cagayano, Non-Cagayano, and Foreign Employed







The total number of employed Filipinos increased by 10.80%. However, due to the restrictions brought by the pandemic, the total number of foreign employees decreased by 23.83%
